NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT OR AMEND A
CONFLICT-OF-INTEREST CODE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sacramento County Board of Education intends to adopt or amend a conflict-of-interest code pursuant to Government Code Section 87300 and 87306. Pursuant to Government Code Section 87302, the code will designate government officials and employees who must disclose certain investments, income, interests in real property and business positions, and who must disqualify themselves from making or participating in the making of governmental decisions affecting those interests.

A written comment period has been established commencing on February 6, 2012 and terminating on March 22, 2012. Any interested person may present written comments concerning the proposed code no later than March 22, 2012 to the Sacramento County Board of Education, P.O. Box 269003, Sacramento, CA 95826-9003. No public hearing on this matter will be held unless any interested person or his or her representative requests no later than 15 days prior to the close of the written comment period, a public hearing.

The Sacramento County Board of Education has determined that the designated positions may make or participate in the making of government decisions, and has outlined the disclosure responsibilities. The Sacramento County Board of Education has available all the information upon which its proposal is based.

The proposed code and amendment provide an expanded description of the requirements of the conflict of interest laws and the ways in which they have been interpreted to assist in understanding these laws so that conflict of interest situations can be monitored and avoided. Additionally, the amendment separates the Sacramento County Board of Education designations from the designations of the Sacramento County Office of Education. The designations under the Sacramento County Office of Education are set forth in separate Administrative Rules and Regulations.
